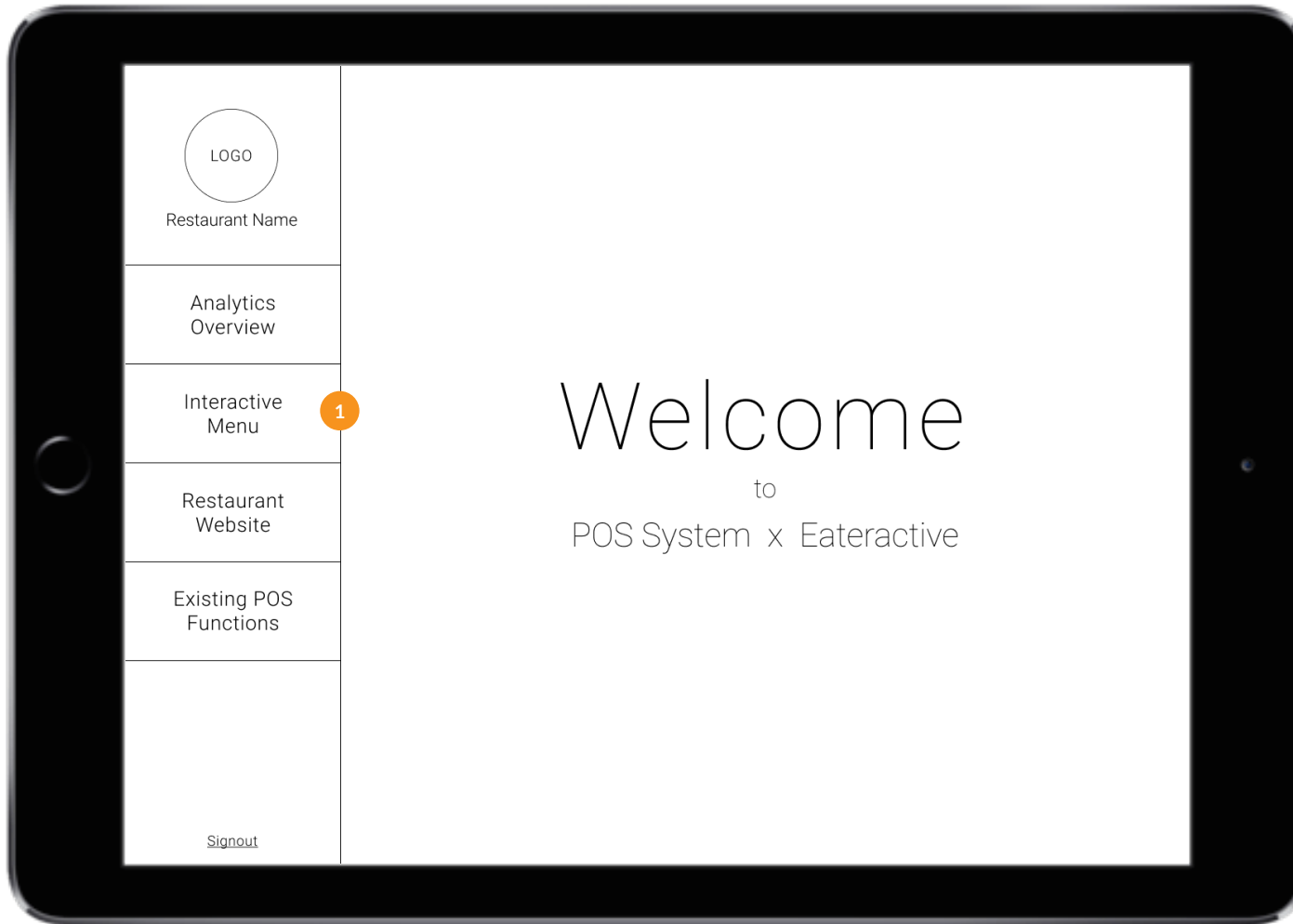
- 1 Tapping in any of these empty boxes will bring up a keyboard, where the user can input info.
- 2 Selecting "Create account" will automatically generate a new restaurant website, which will support many of the features Eateractive offers.
- 3 Selecting here will bring about a drop down menu, where the user can scroll through a list of template photos, and then select one.
- 4 Selecting here will bring about a drop down menu, where the user can scroll through a list of color schemes, and then select one.

- 1 Once the website has been created, the user will be navigated to the POS System x Eateractive welcome page.
- 2 Now that the user is signed in, clicking here will sign out the user and return them to the login page.

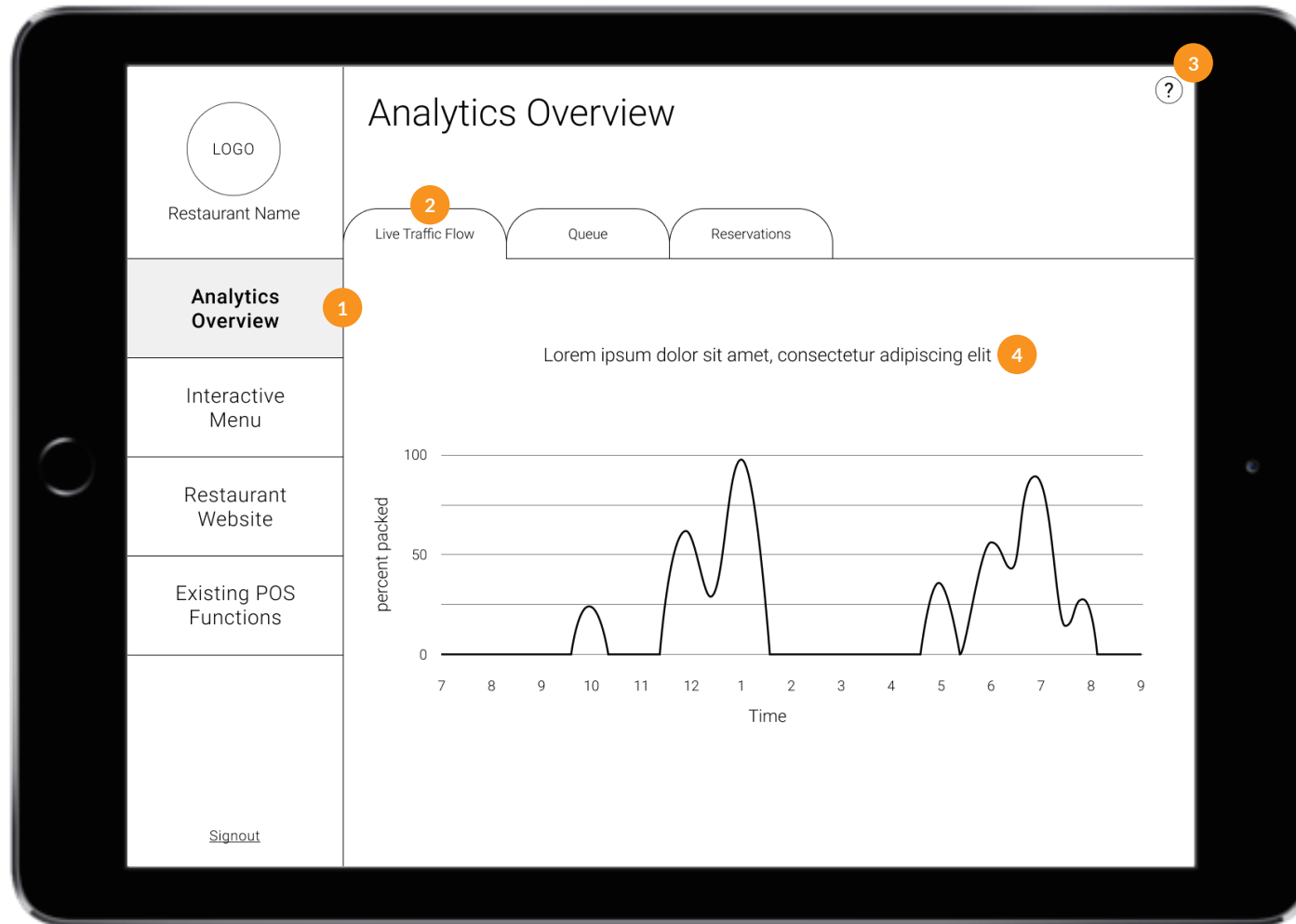

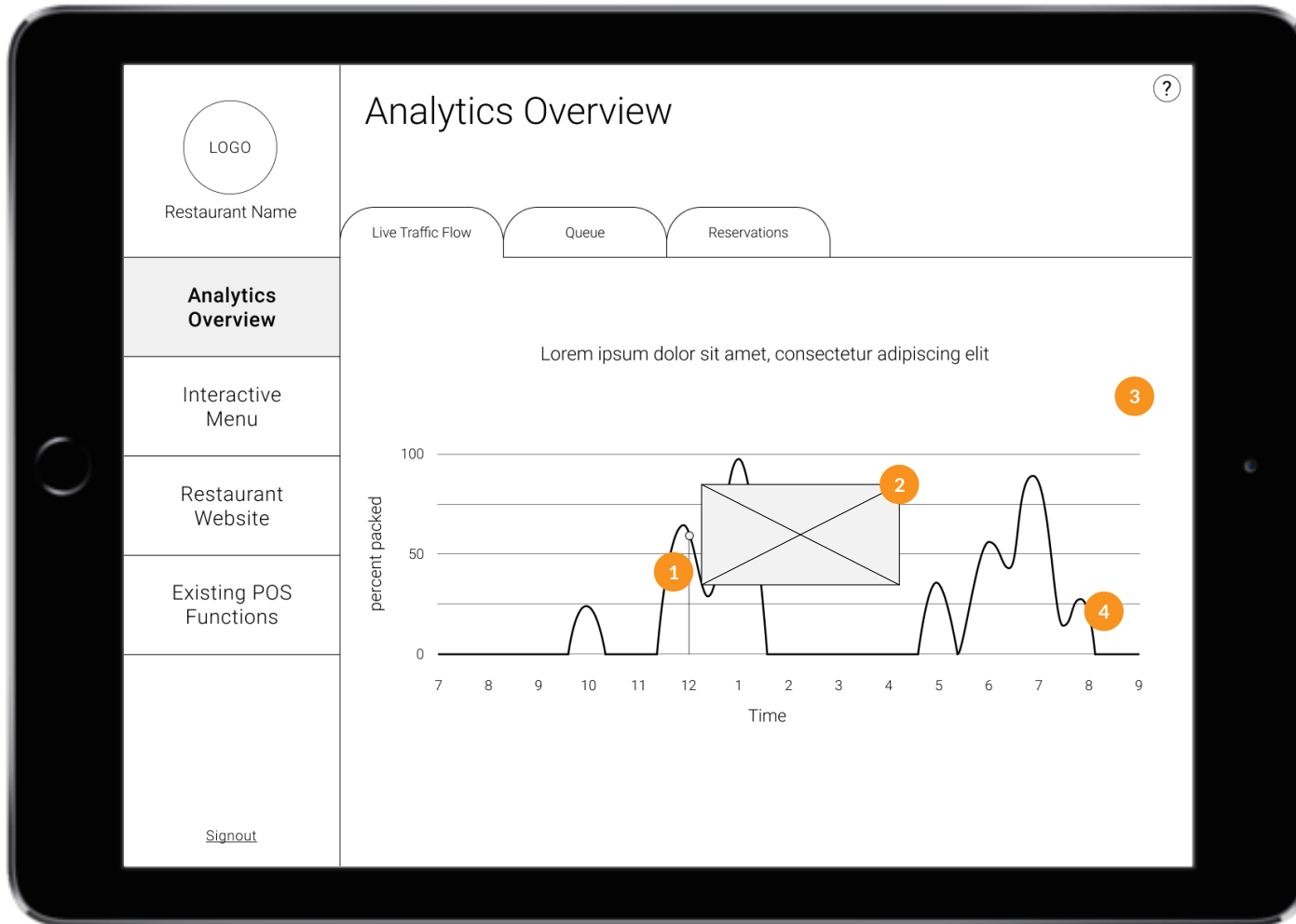


# Analytics Overview: Live Traffic Flow



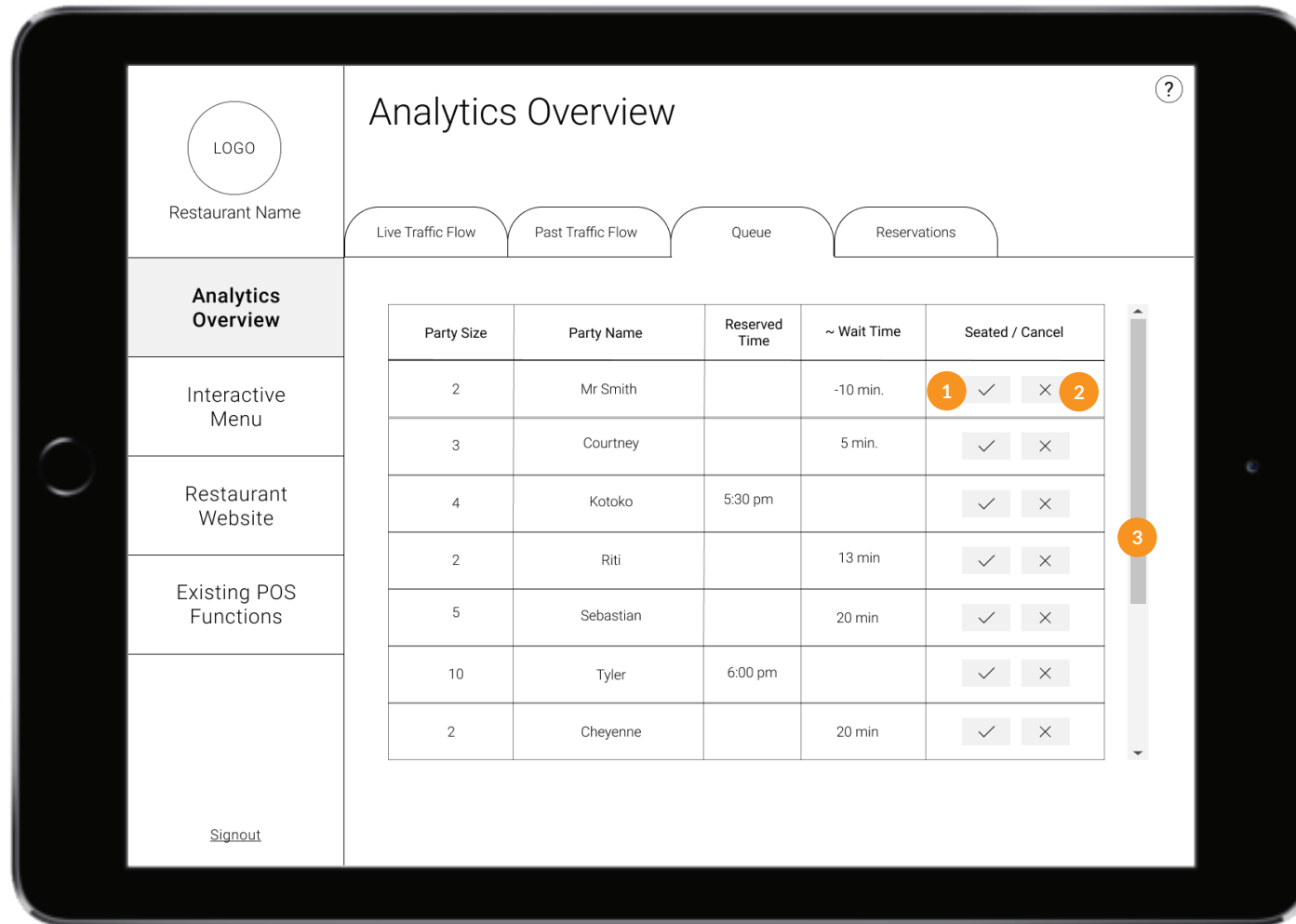
- 1 Active page (Analytics Overview) is highlighted.
- 2 Active tab (Live Traffic Flow) is open.
- 3 Help button will allow the user to email a help center with questions.
- 4 Text instructing users to select points on the graph to learn about specific wait times at that hour.

# Analytics Overview: Live Traffic Flow



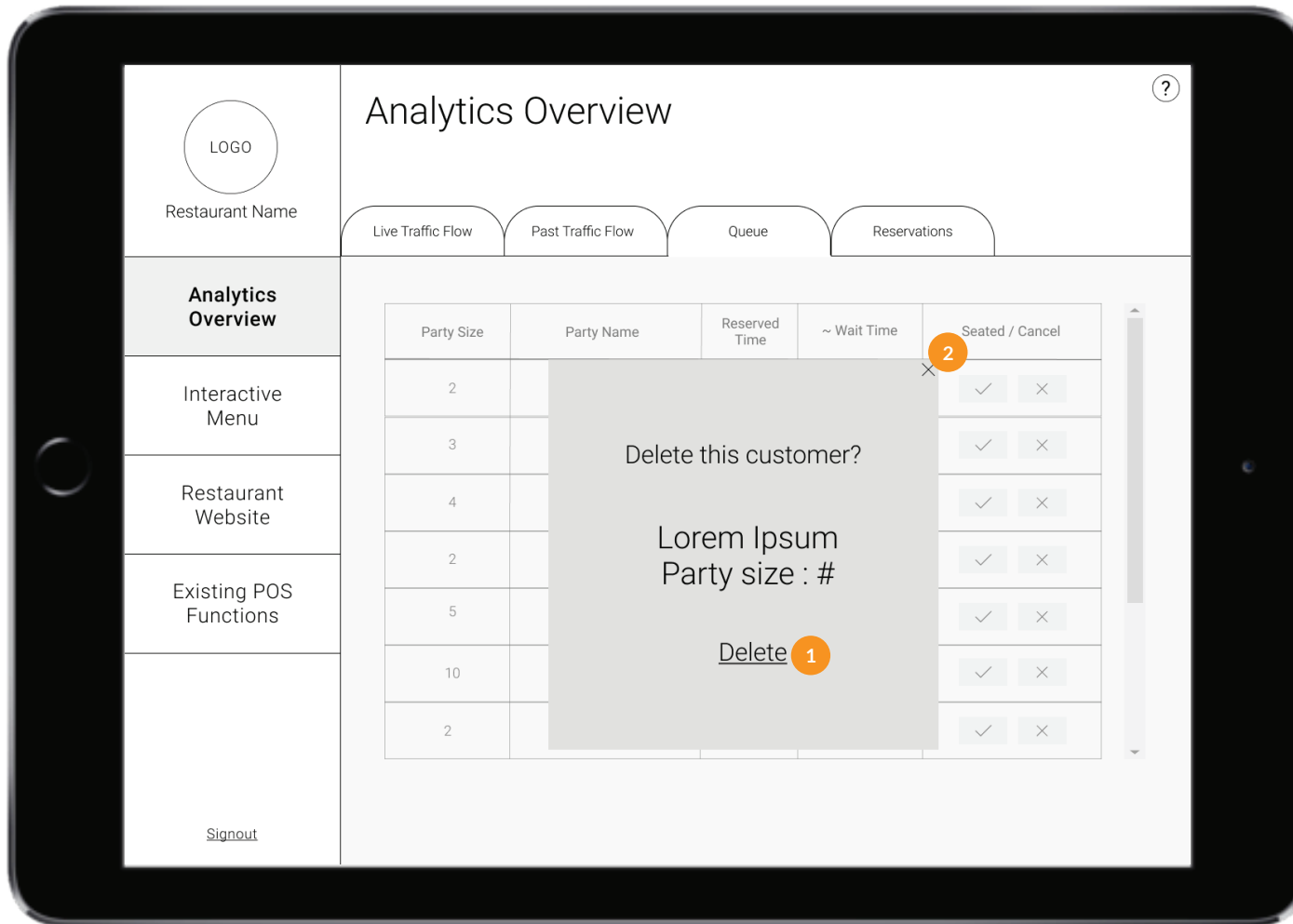
- 1 Selecting a point on the graph will bring about a line connecting the graph and time axis, so users know what time they are receiving information for.
- 2 Selecting a point on the graph will also bring up a box displaying wait times at that hour.
- 3 Selecting a point in the traffic tab but not on the graph will close the box.
- 4 Selecting a different point on the graph will make the existing box disappear, and a new one will take its place.

# Analytics Overview: Queue



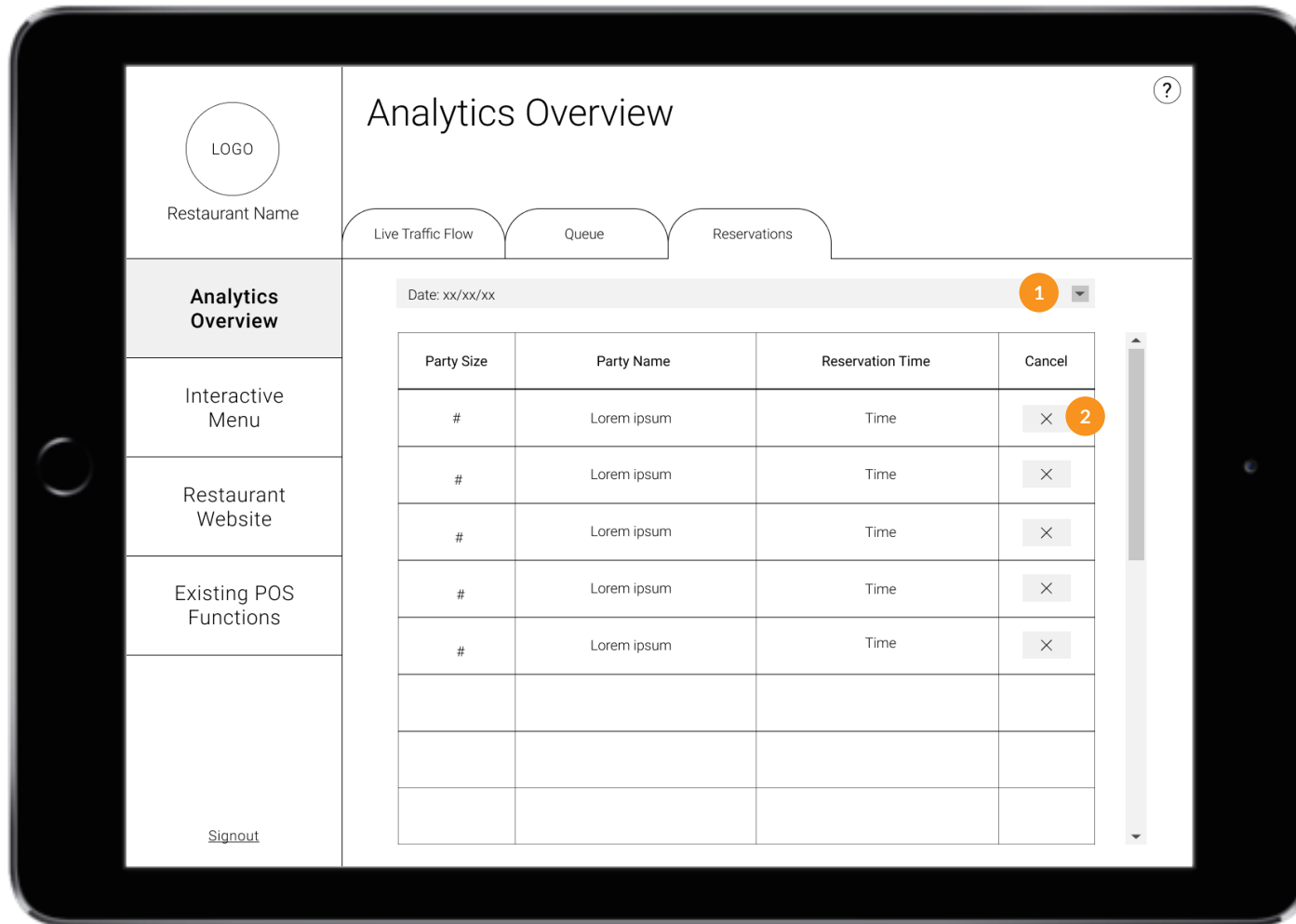
- 1 The user can tap here to confirm a party has arrived. Every other party will move up in the list.
- 2 Tapping here will bring up a pop-up to confirm whether the user wants to delete a party from the queue.
- 3 The user can scroll through the parties in the queue (if the list is long enough).

# Queue: Confirm Deletion



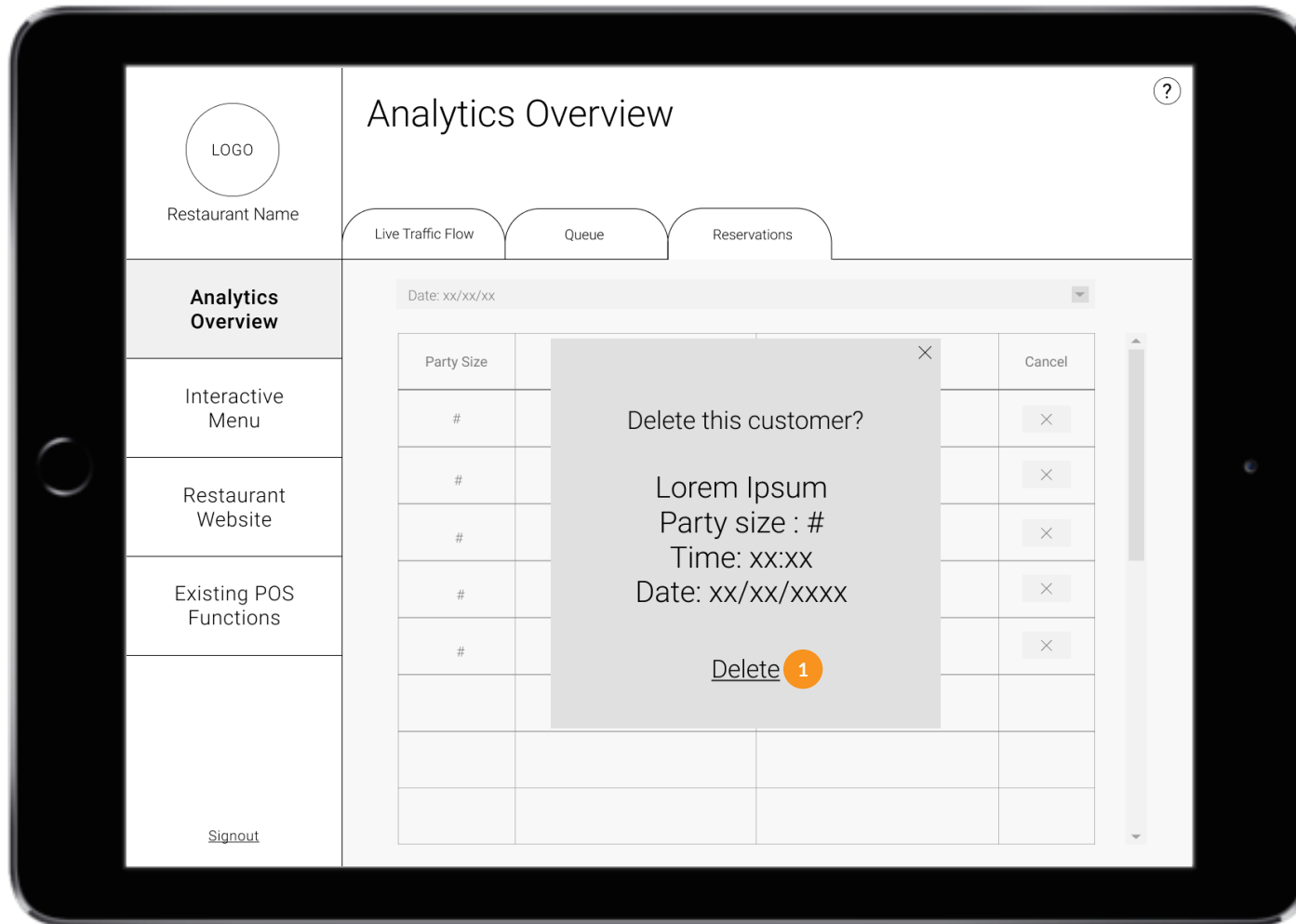
- 1 Selecting "Delete" will remove that party from the queue and return the user to the queue page. Every party below will move up one place.
- 2 Selecting here will not delete the party, and will return the user to the queue page.

# Reservations



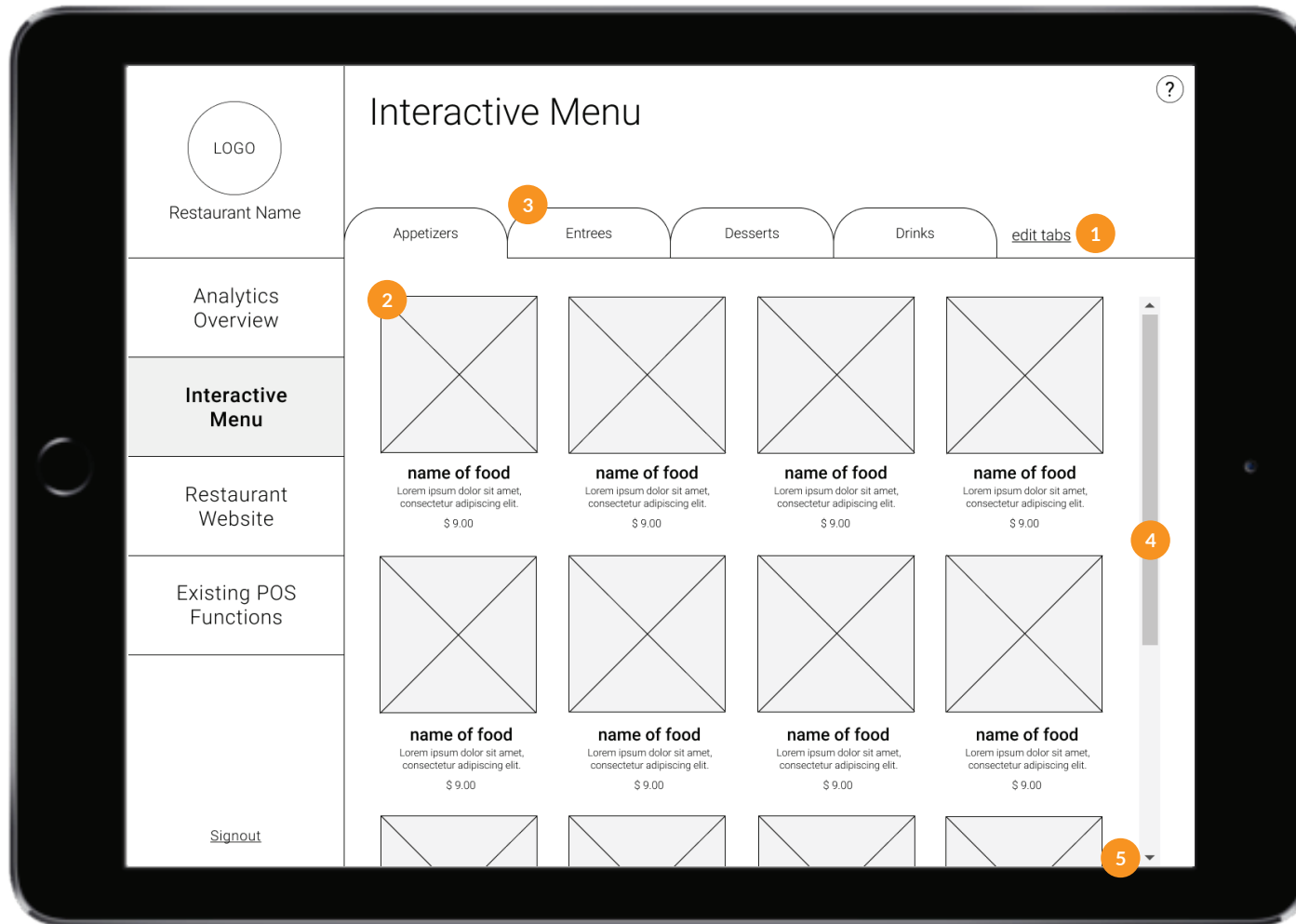
- 1 Selecting here will bring about a drop down menu, where the user can change the date and see the reservation list for different dates.
- 2 Tapping here will bring up a pop-up to confirm whether the user wants to delete a reservation from the list.

# Reservations: Confirm Deletion



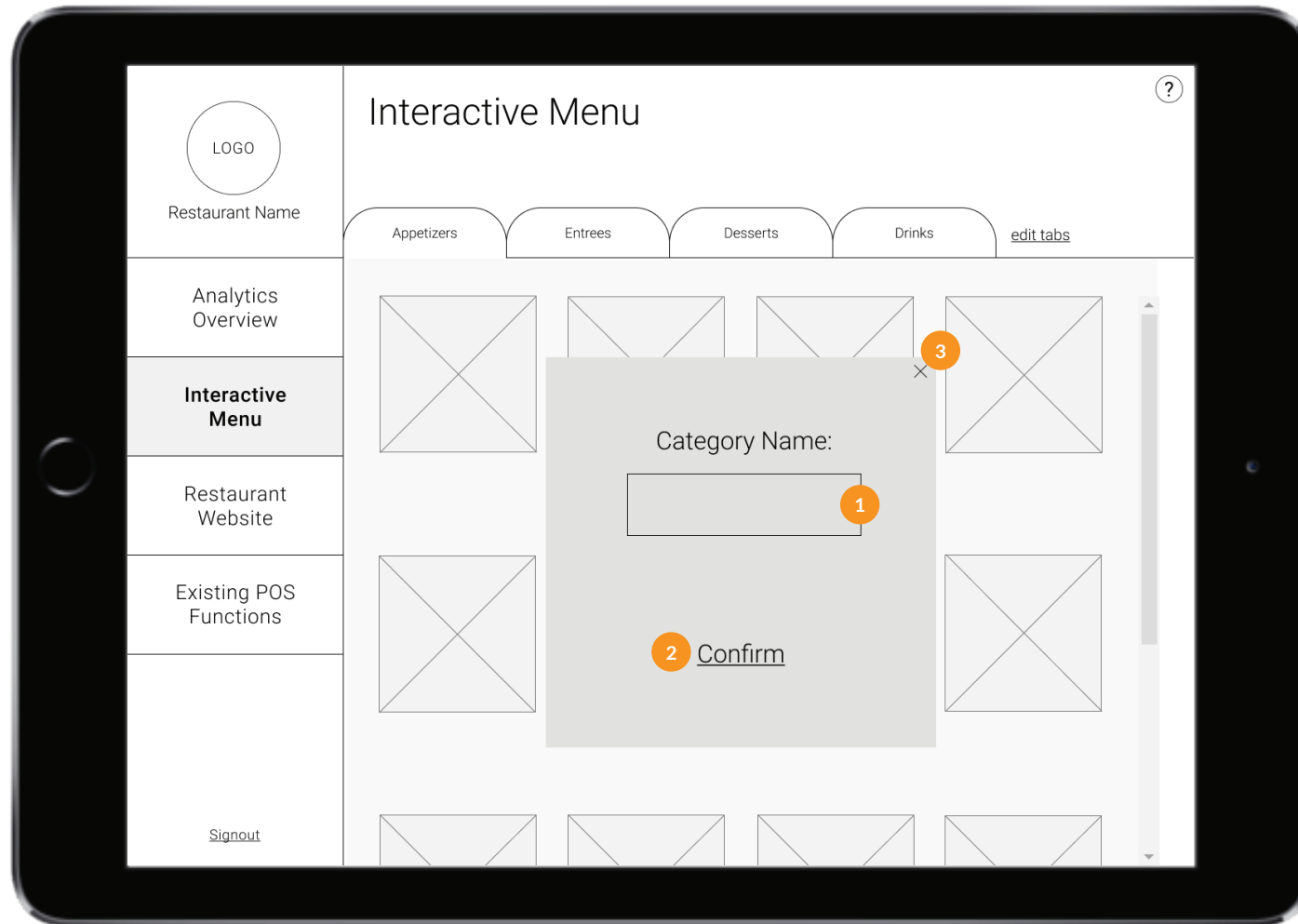
- 1 Selecting "Delete" will remove that party from the reservations list and return the user to the reservations page. Every party below will move up one place.

# Interactive Menu



- 1 Selecting “edit tabs” will take the user to a pop-up where they can add a new category of food.
- 2 Selecting the picture of food will take the user to a page where they can look at a brief description of the item, nutrition info, price, ingredients, and reviews.
- 3 The user can tap on each tab to view the different categories of the menu.
- 4 The user can use the scroll bar to view the full list of items in each category.
- 5 The last item in the list will be an “add item” box. This option is hidden from view because the menus are relatively stable and users will want to view menu items more frequently than they will want to add items.

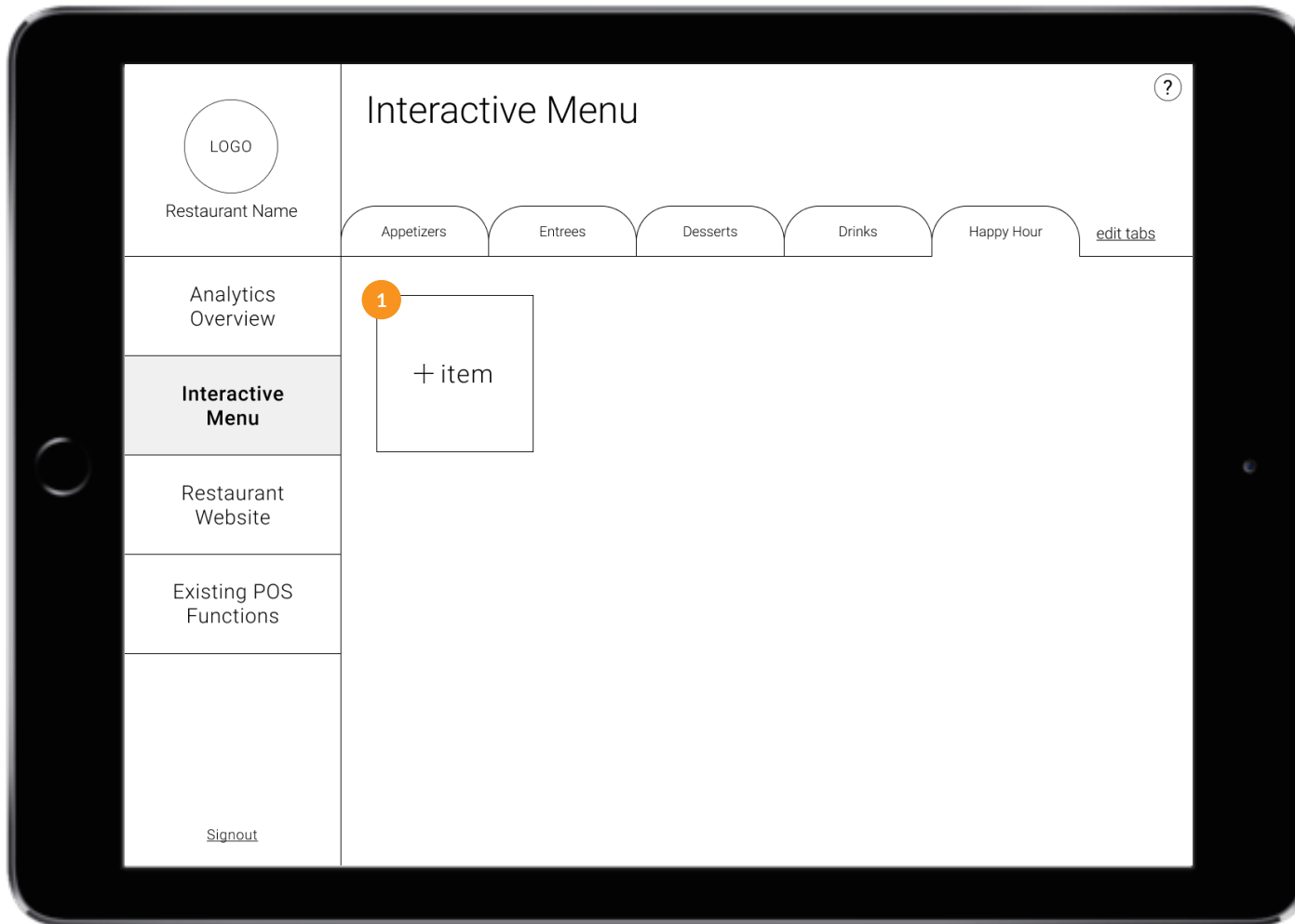
# Interactive Menu: Add Tab



- 1 Selecting "Enter" will bring up a keyboard, where the user can input the category name.
- 2 Selecting "Confirm" will add the category to the menu and navigate the user to the new category page.
- 3 Selecting here will close the pop-up screen instead of adding a new category. The user will be returned to the previous category page.



# Interactive Menu: New Category



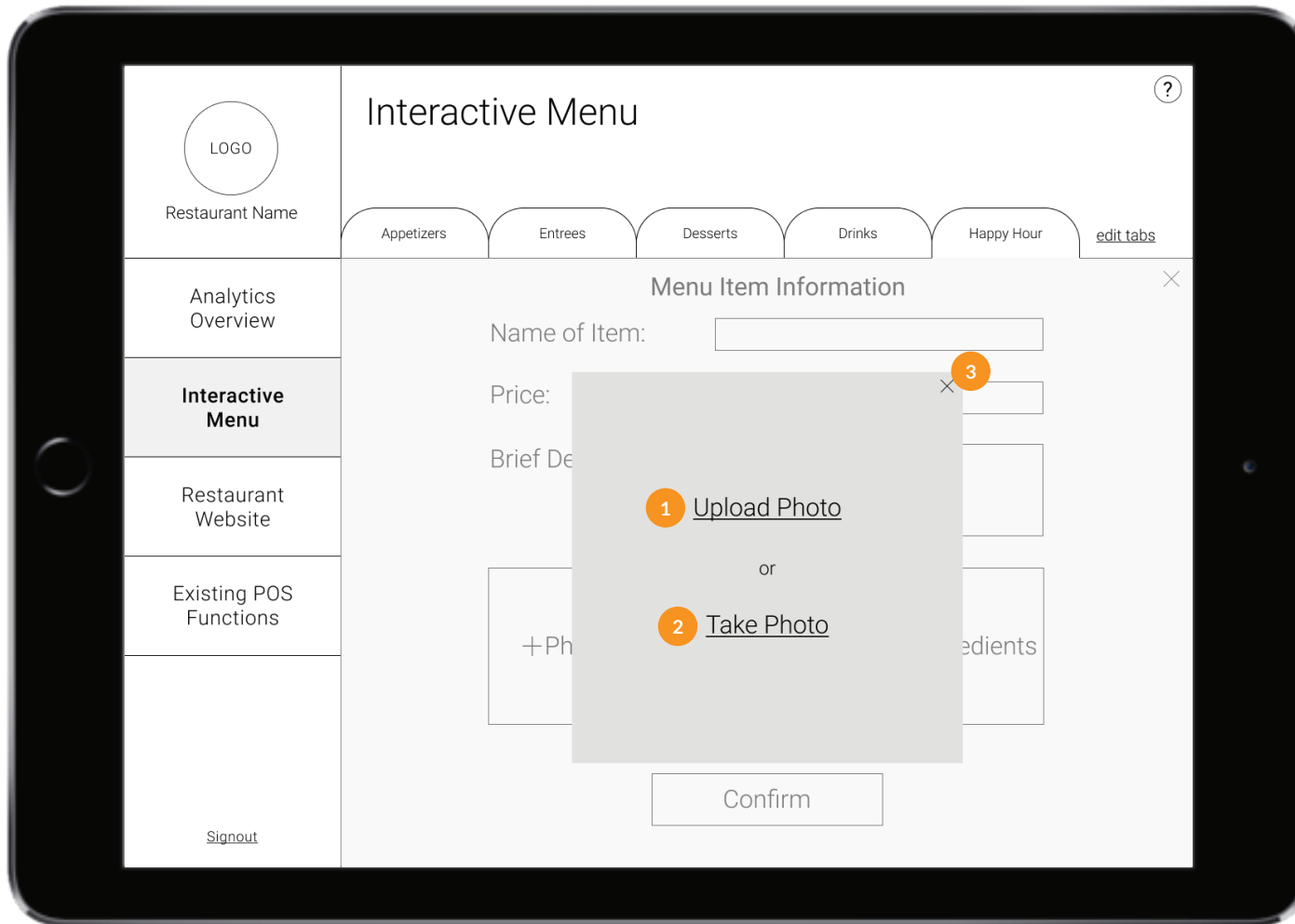
- 1 Selecting here will bring the user to a different page, where they can input information about a new menu item. The item will be a part of the active category (i.e. Happy Hour).

# Interactive Menu: Adding an Item

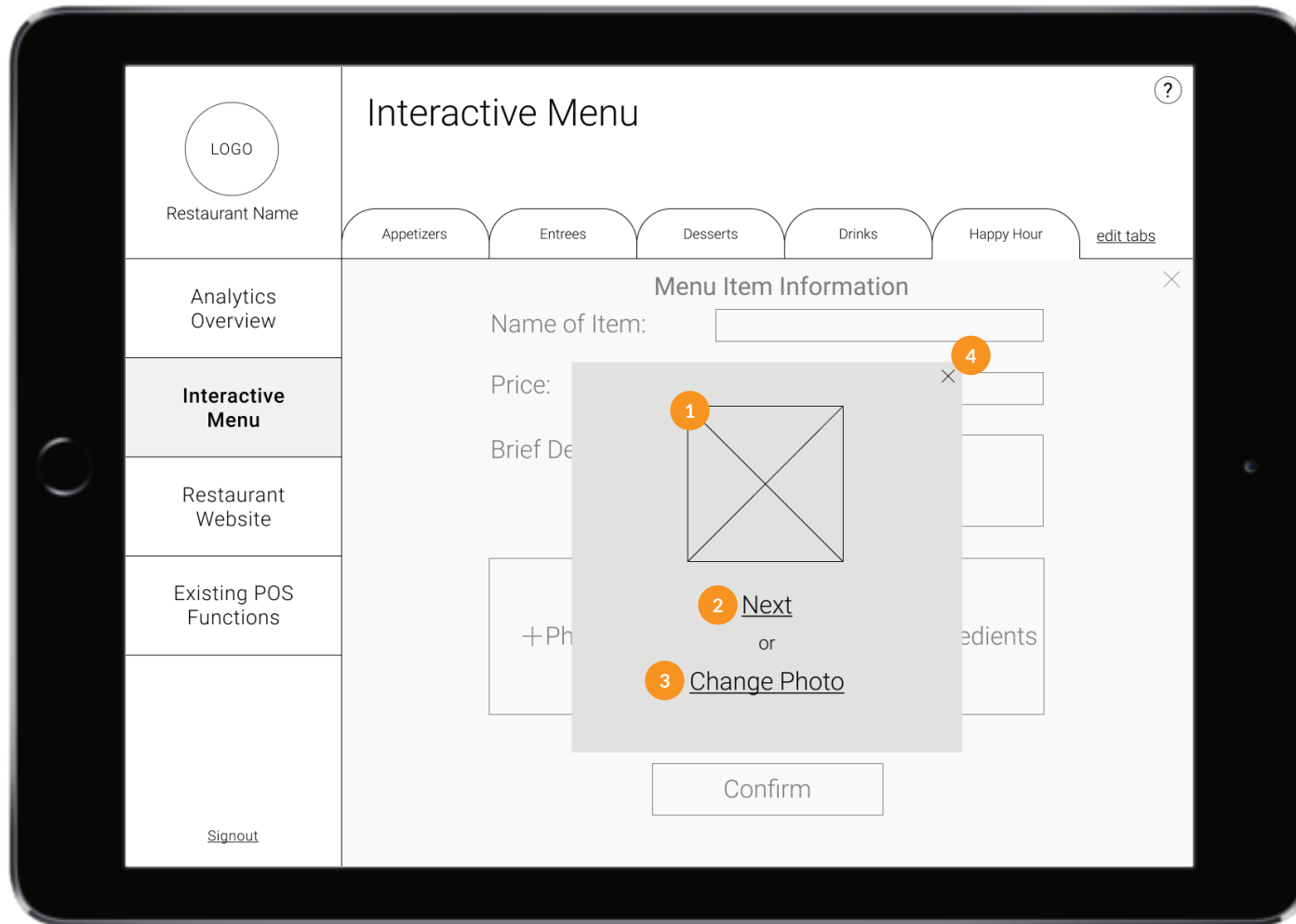
- 1 Selecting "Enter" will bring up a keyboard, where the user can input the item name.

- 3 Selecting "Enter" will bring up a keyboard, where the user can input an item description.
- 4 Selecting this block will take the user to a pop-up screen, where they can upload a photo of the menu item.
- 5 Selecting here will exit the user from the item information page and return them to the previous view category page.

# Interactive Menu: Upload Photo



- 1 Selecting "Upload Photo" will take the user to the photos in their camera roll.
- 2 Selecting "Take Photo" will take the user to a camera.
- 3 Tapping here will exit the user from the pop-up.

# Interactive Menu: Confirm Photo



- 1 This block shows what the uploaded image will look like on the POS System and website.
- 2 Selecting "Next" will confirm the upload and return the user to the same item information page.
- 3 Selecting "Change Photo" will take the user back to the previous upload photo pop-up.
- 4 Tapping here will exit the user from the pop-up.



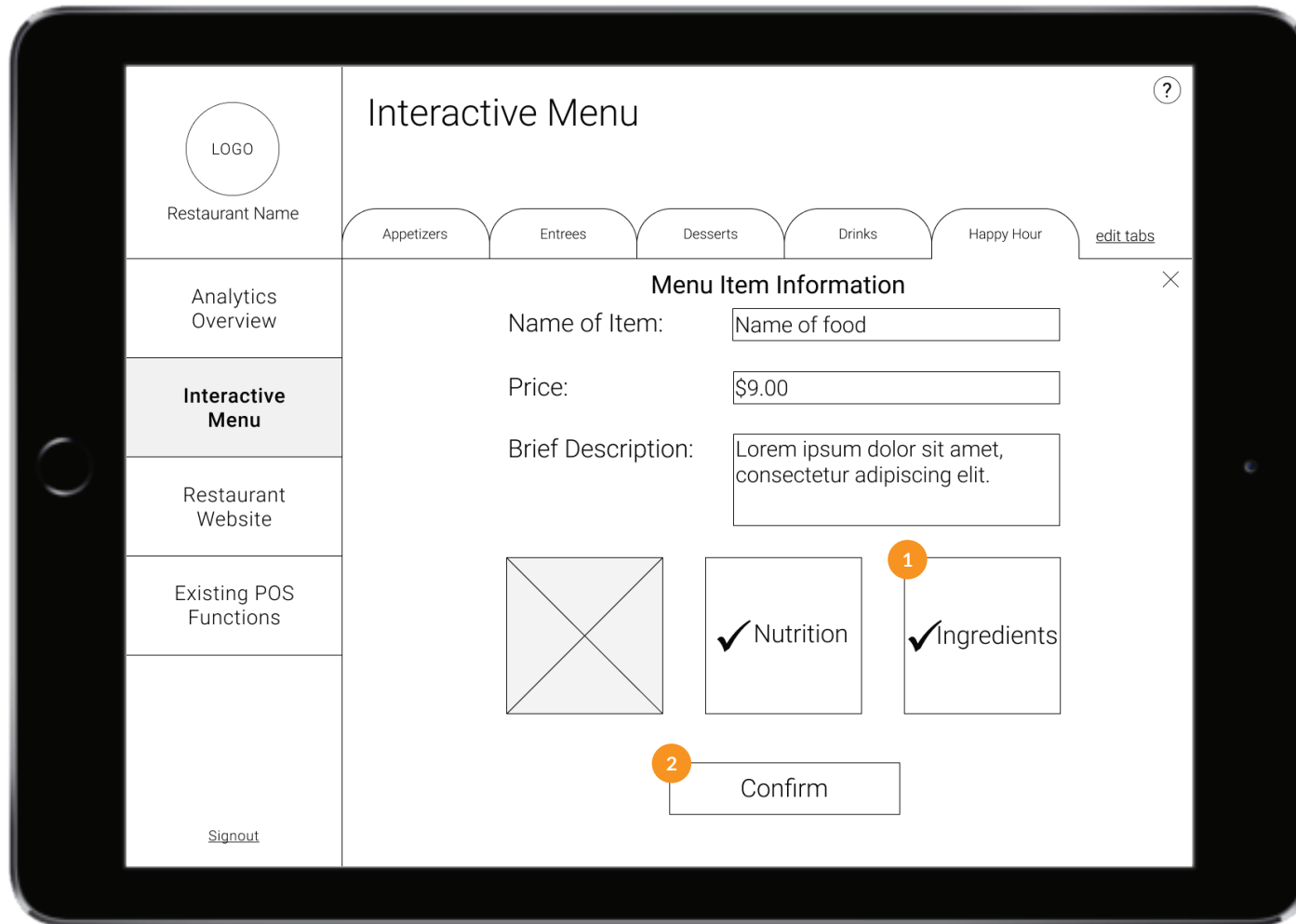

- 3 Selecting "Next" will save the information and return the user to the item information page.
- 4 Selecting here will exit the pop-up and return the user to the item information page.

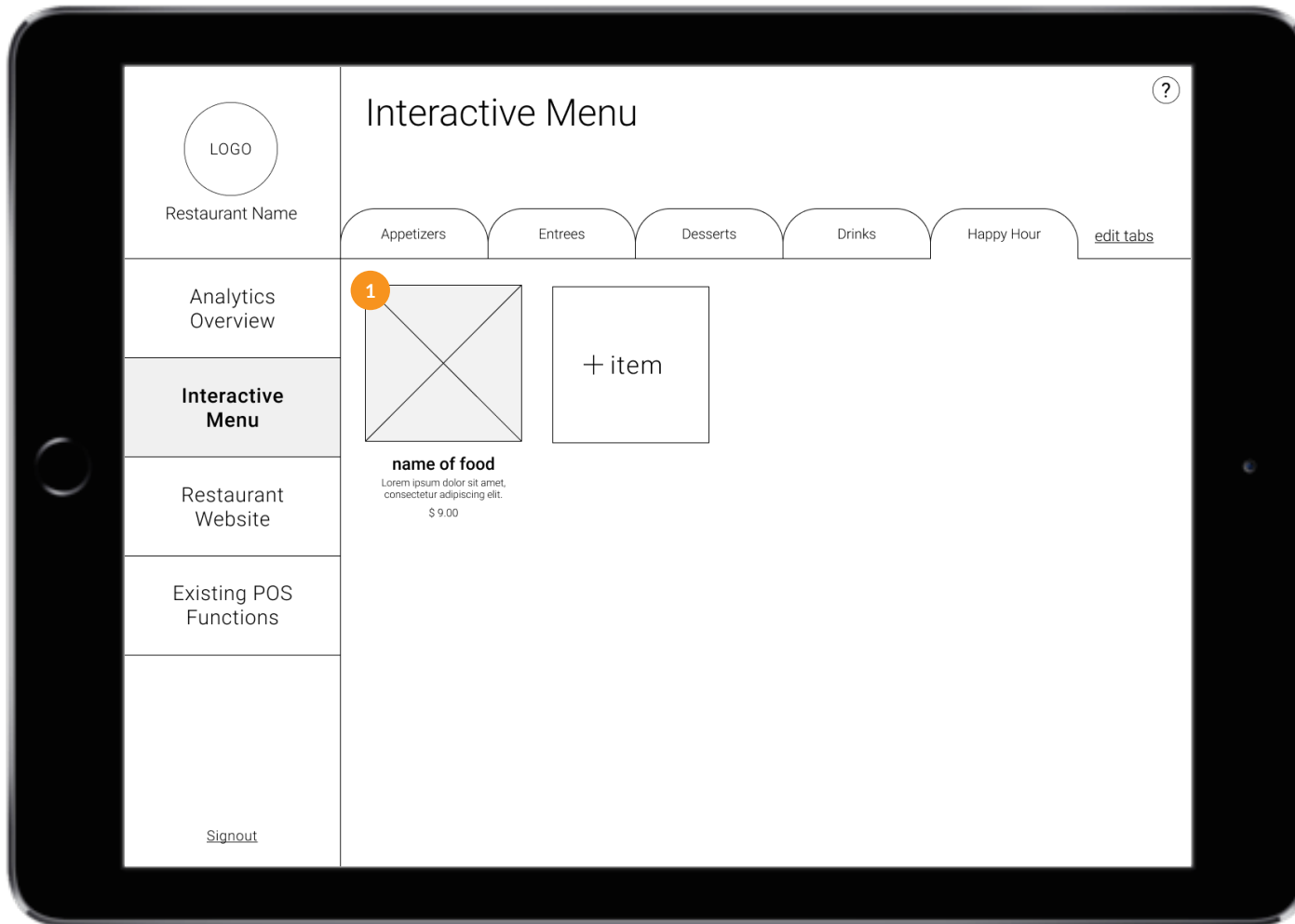


# Interactive Menu



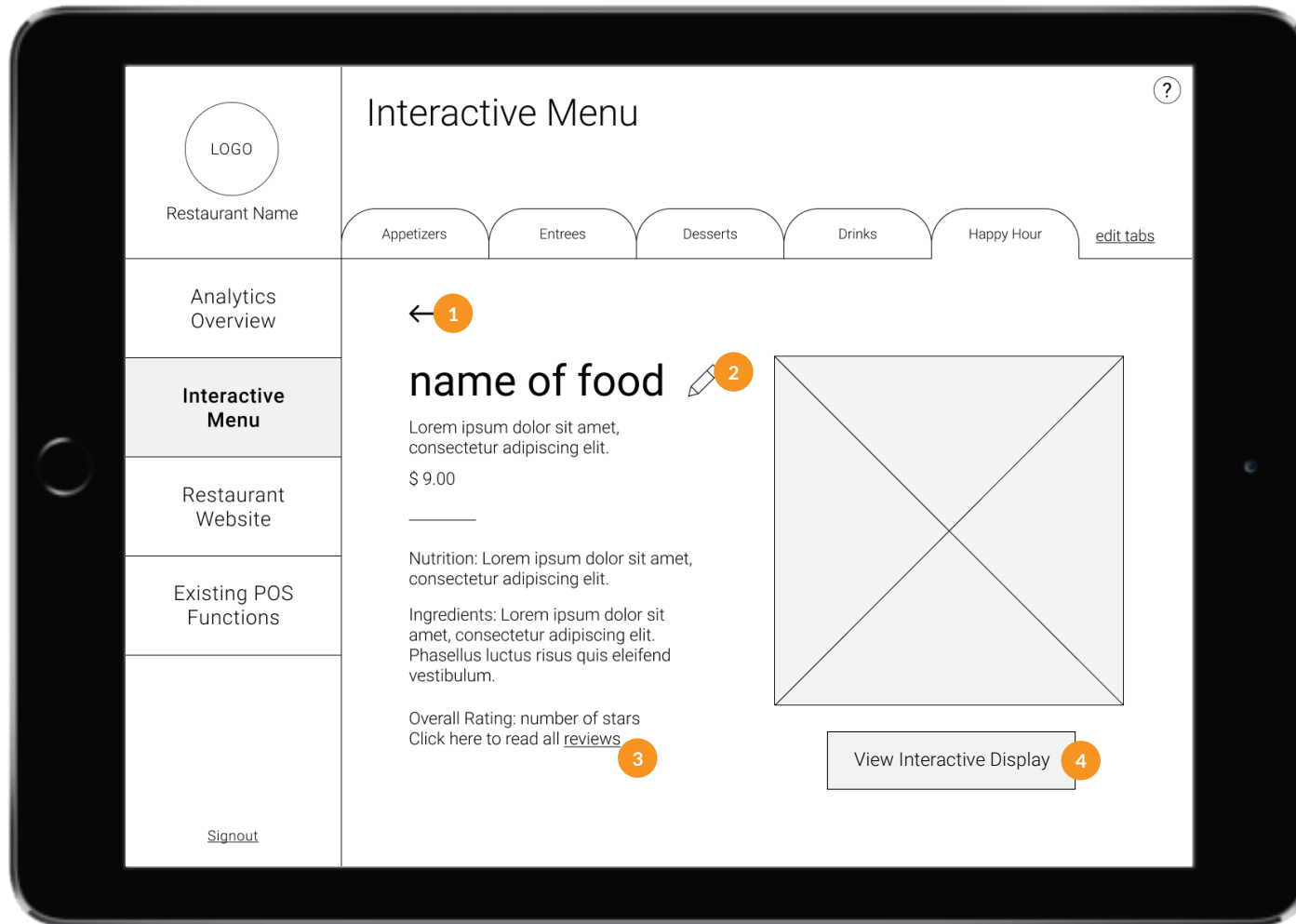
- 1 Selecting the ingredients box will bring the user to same ingredient pop-up as before.
- 2 Tapping "Confirm" takes the user back to the category page to which the item is being added (i.e Happy Hour). The new menu item will appear there.

# Interactive Menu: View Category



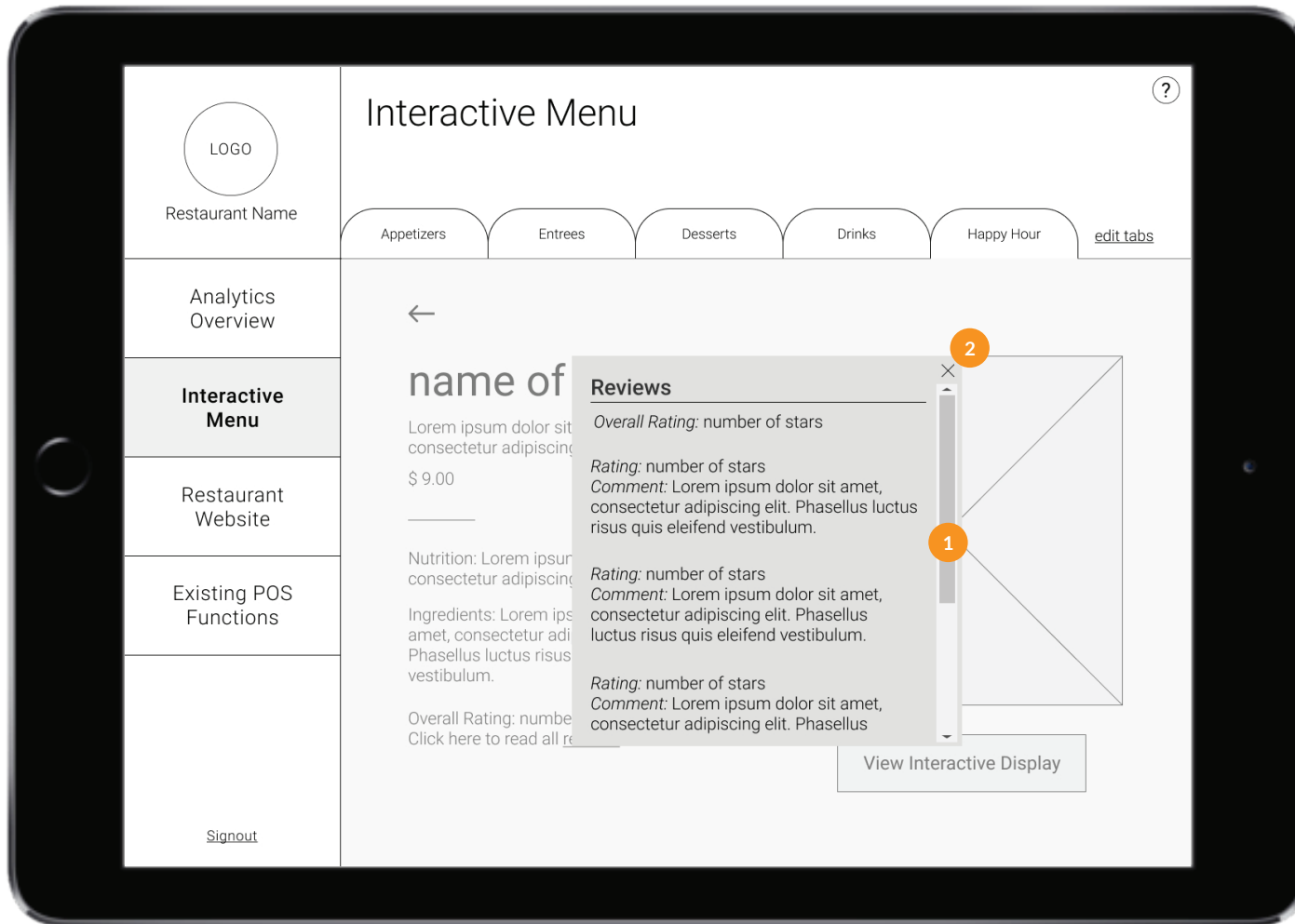
- 1 Selecting the image block takes the user to a page with more detailed information of that item.

# Interactive Menu: View Item



- 1 Selecting here takes the user back to the previous category page.
- 2 Selecting here takes the user to the same item information form page used to add new items, where they can edit the item information.
- 3 Selecting "reviews" takes the user to a pop-up of a list of all the item's reviews.
- 4 Selecting here allows the owner to view an automatically generated augmented reality version of the menu item.

# Interactive Menu: View Reviews

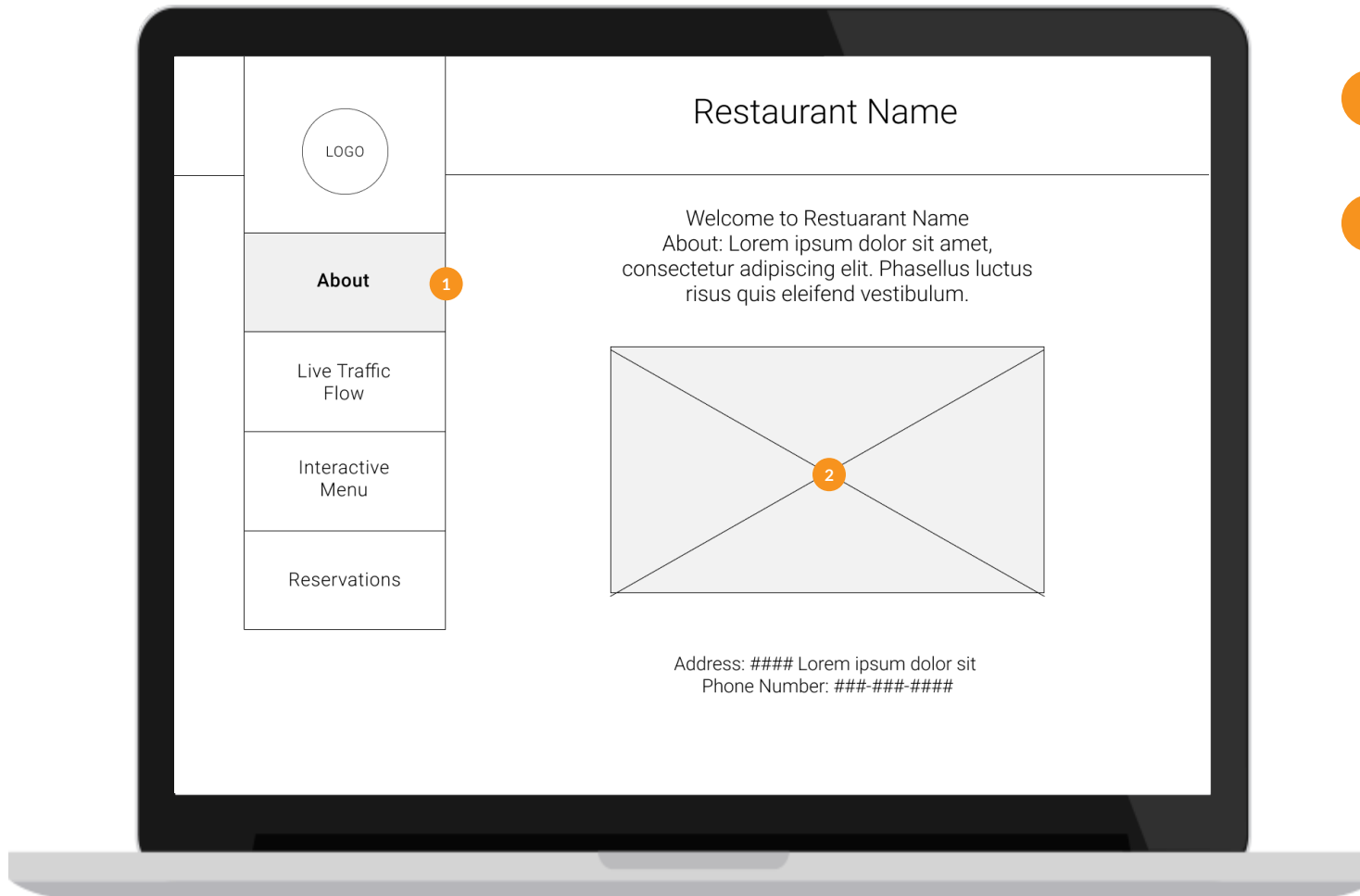


1 The user can use the scroll bar to view the full list of item reviews.

2 Selecting here exits the pop-up and returns the user to the previous view item page.

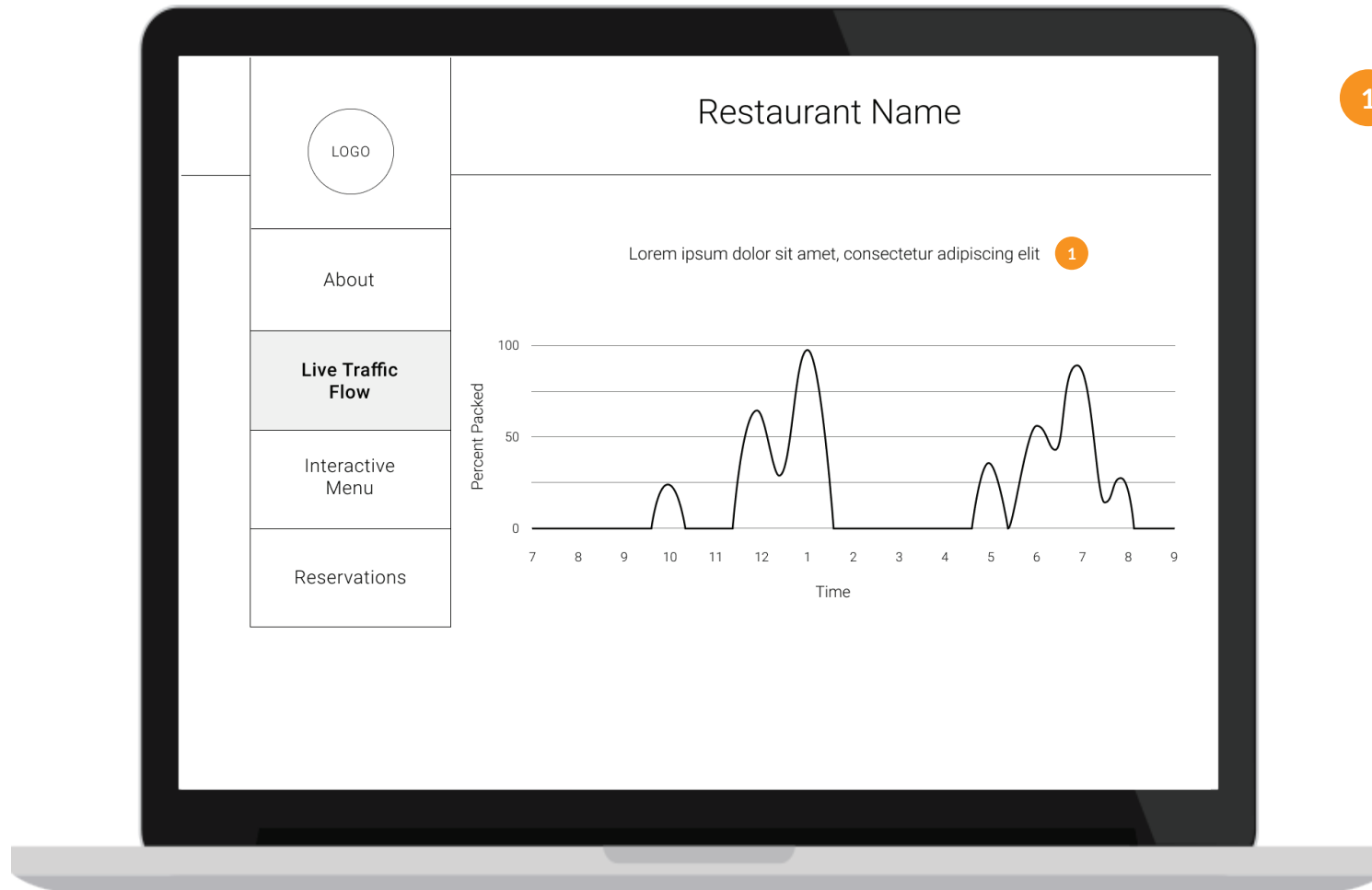

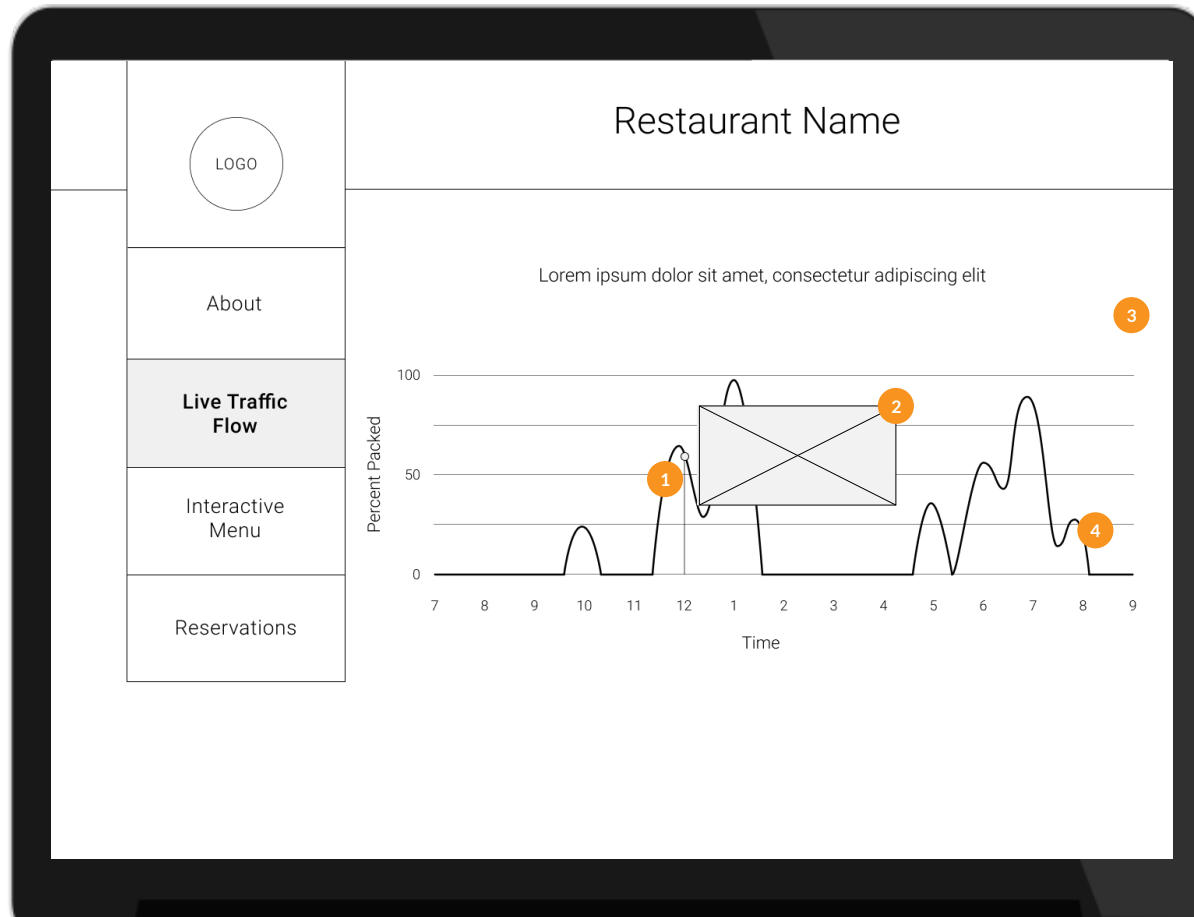

1 Text instructing users to hover over points on the graph to learn about specific wait times at that hour.

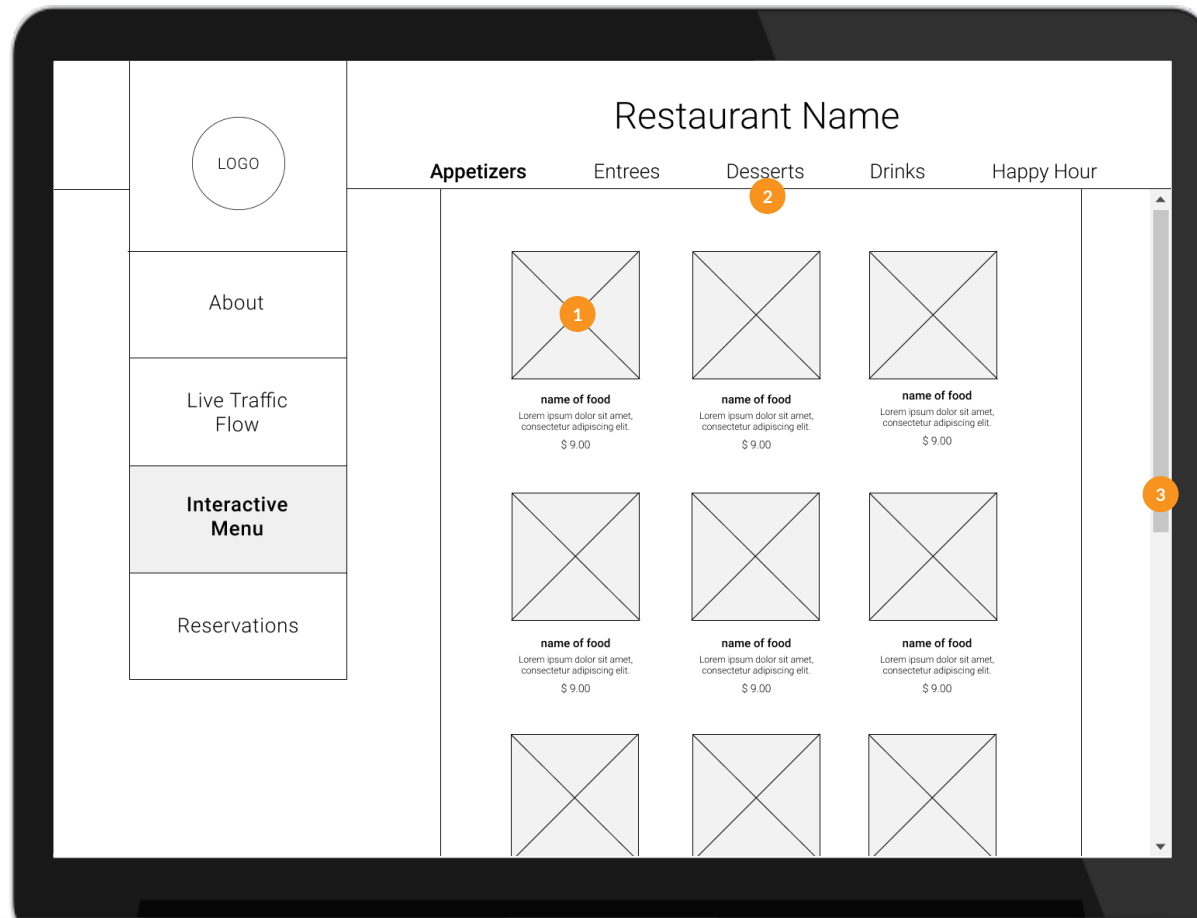
# Live Traffic Flow



- 1 Hovering over a point on the graph will bring about a line connecting the graph and time axis, so users know what time they are receiving information for.
- 2 Hovering over a point on the graph will also bring up a box displaying wait times at that hour.
- 3 Hovering over a point in the traffic tab but not on the graph will make the box disappear.
- 4 Hovering over a different point on the graph will make the existing box disappear, and a new one will take its place.

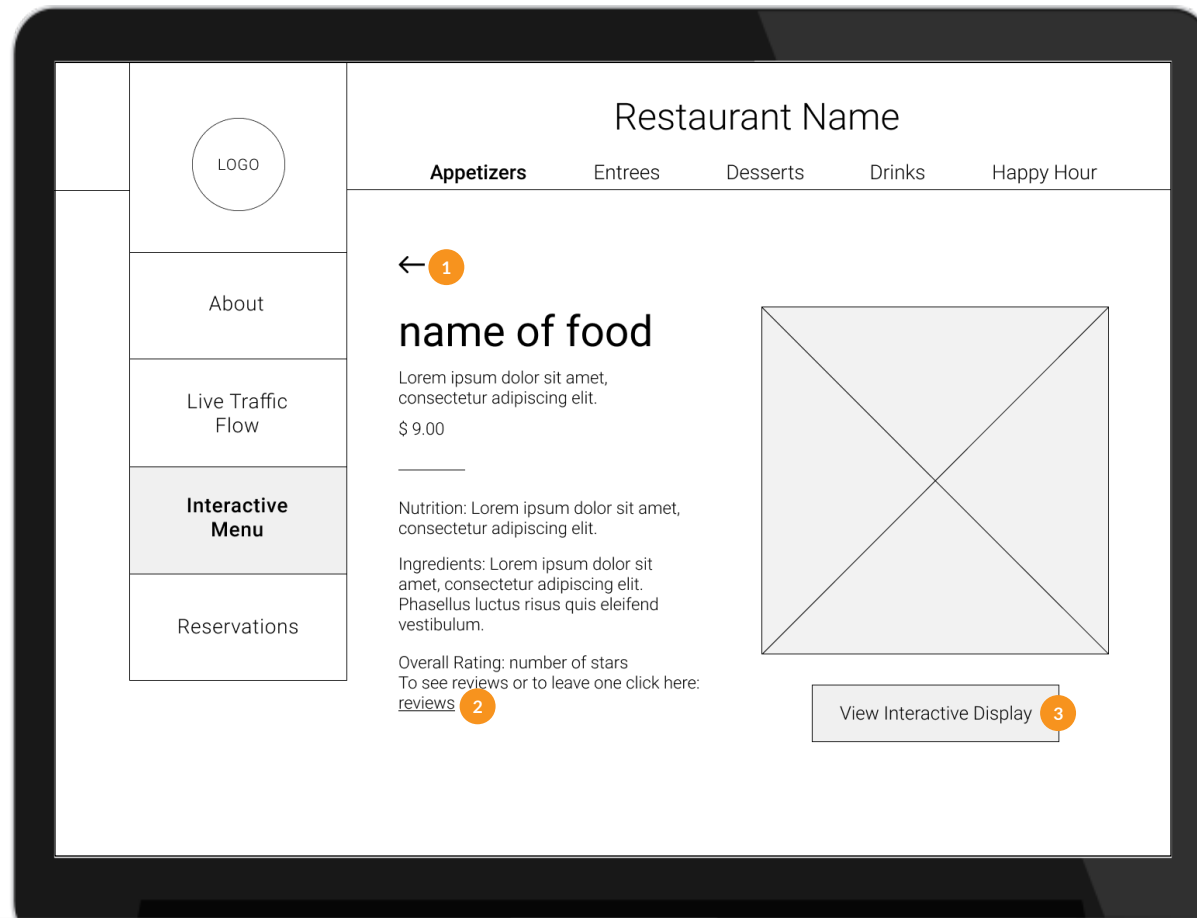


# Interactive Menu



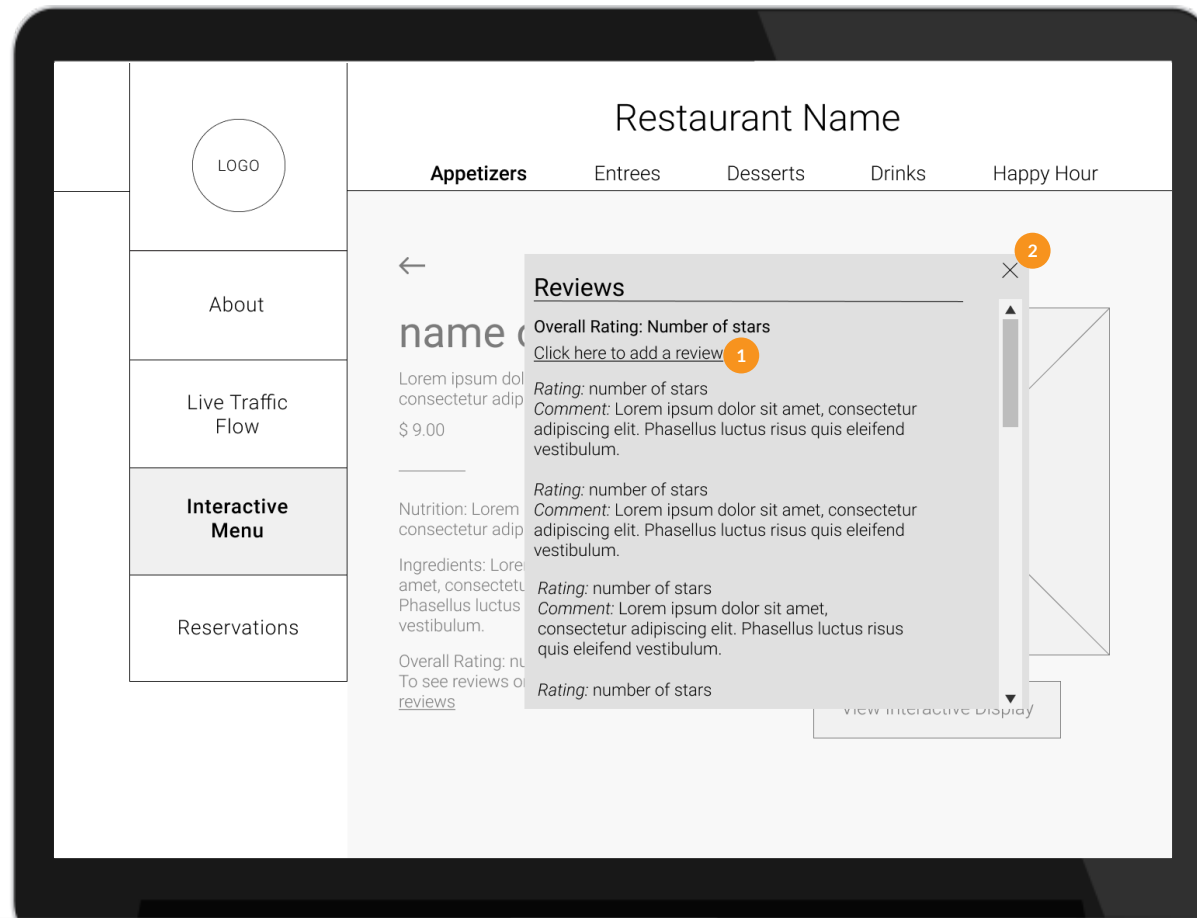
- 1 The user can click on each image block to view more detailed information about that item.
- 2 The user can click different tabs to view each category of the menu.
- 3 The user can use the scroll bar to view the full list of items in each category.

# Interactive Menu: View Item



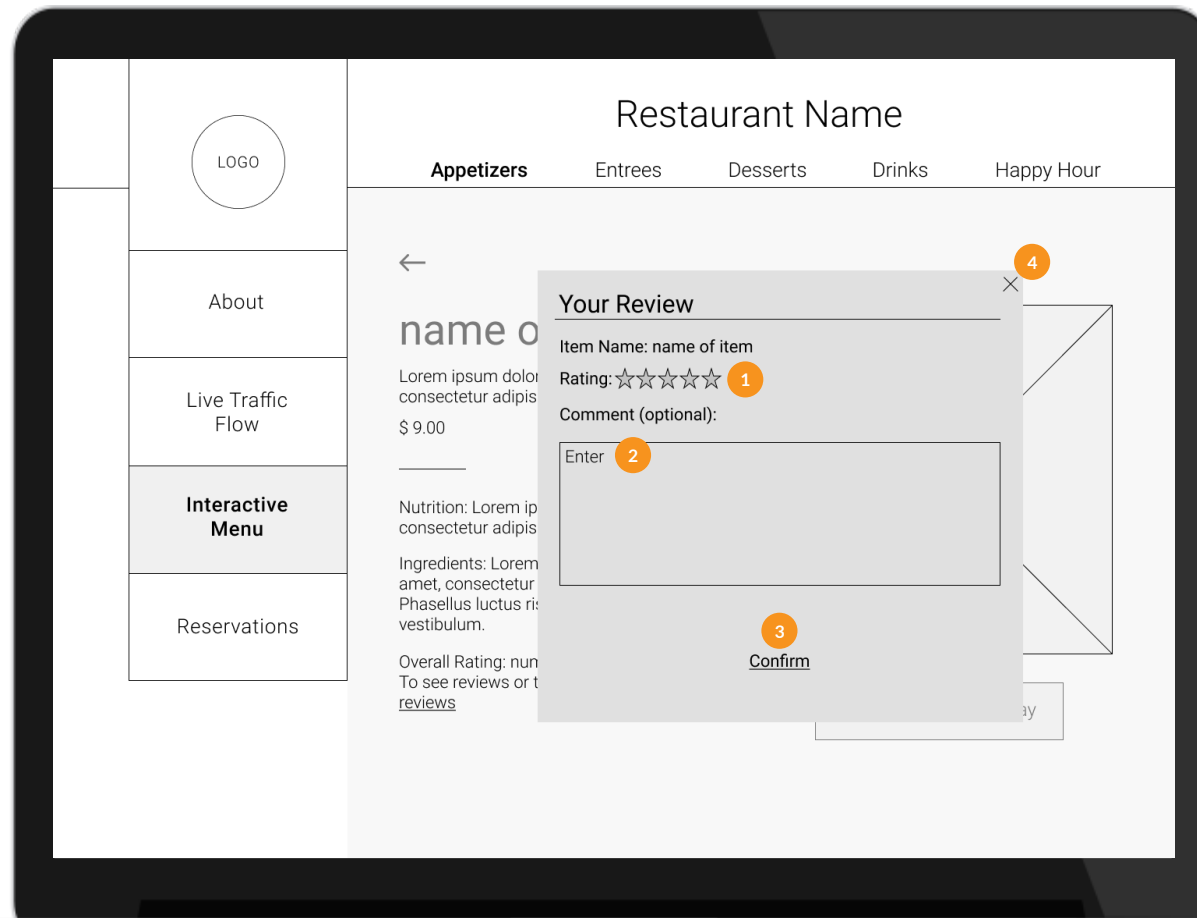
- 1 Selecting here takes the user back to the previous category page.
- 2 Selecting "reviews" will open a pop-up showing all item reviews.
- 3 The user can click here to view an augmented reality version of the specified menu item.

# Interactive Menu: View Reviews



- 1 Clicking here will directly open another pop-up, where the user can enter an item review.
- 2 Selecting here will return the user to the previous view item page.

# Interactive Menu: Leave Review



- 1 Clicking on a star will create the item rating. The user can click on a different star to change the rating.
- 2 Selecting the textbox will bring up a keyboard, where the user can input a comment.
- 3 Clicking "Confirm" will save the review and add it to the list of item reviews. The pop-up will close and the user will be returned to the view item page.
- 4 Selecting here will close the pop-up and return the user back to the view item page.
